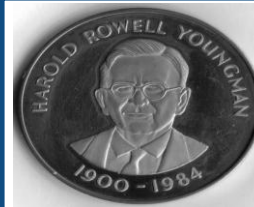


The East Anglian Association of Anaesthetists' Core Topics 2021 and Harold Youngman Prize Meeting will take place on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> and Friday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2021. The meeting will take place on a professional virtual platform run by an audio visual company as sadly it still remains uncertain as to what the situation with the pandemic will be in November to run a face to face meeting.

The virtual platform will feature the live programme which will be streamed on both days, an area with poster presentations and an area for the exhibitors and sponsors.
