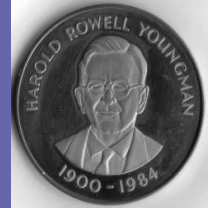

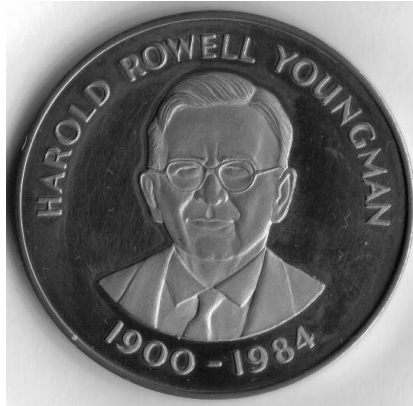
Full programme to follow.
